

UKCAT Preliminary Scores 2017

Cognitive Subtests

Data is valid up to the 8th September 2017 when 10,274 candidates had taken the test. Candidates should **use these figures as a rough guide** to judge their own performance. Averages will change as the testing cycle progresses. End of testing statistics will be published on 6th October 2017.

2017 is the first year that the Decision Making subtest has been operational. Please bear in mind the following information when interpreting the data below:

- In 2015 the test comprised 4 subtests (Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning, Abstract Reasoning and Decision Analysis); the total score ranged from 1200 to 3600.
- In 2016 the test comprised 3 subtests (Verbal Reasoning, Quantitative Reasoning and Abstract Reasoning); the total score ranged from 900 to 2700.

The 2017 mean average score (up to 8th September) is 2598.
